The CSAVR is submitting a Call for Proposals for the 2019 Fall Conference, October 28th-30th, at the Hyatt Regency, Jacksonville, FL., on the topics bulleted below. Proposals are being solicited for General Sessions. Concurrent Sessions and Round Tables and will be considered on a first come, first serve basis, based on merit and available space on the Agenda. If you have a session preference, please indicate it when your proposal is submitted. We will consider your preference as Agenda space permits. Other topics for presentation will also be considered if space is available after all solicited proposals have been reviewed.

The CSAVR is requesting Round Table presentations be structured by a process. sometimes referred to as speed dating, where presenters will provide an overview of the topic presented in 15-20 minutes. Participants would then have an opportunity to discuss the topic with the presenter/s and other participants and ask questions. Presenters are asked to provide access to more detailed information on the topic in written format. Written materials must also be made available in accessible formats. The intent of these sessions will be to provide an opportunity for participants to dialogue with the presenters and each other on topics that are very important to them. We anticipate having a number of Round Tables on various topics and participants would have the opportunity to join other tables, should they want to do so. We will have flip charts and note takers for each roundtable to capture any key ideas or learning points not addressed in the presentations or written materials. At the end of the roundtables the note takers will complete a short template stating the presentation title, the name(s) of the presenter(s), and bullets of any key ideas or learning points noted in the discussions. This material will then be available to presenters and CSAVR. Round Tables will be conducted for 60 minutes.
